

EVALUATION SCHEME FOR IT COMPETITIONS

Evaluation process for IT competitions is done in the same way of Science Competitions. Maximum score for each item is hundred. Equal weightage may be given for each aspect.

Aspects to be considered.

I. Digital Painting

- 1) Whether the student's work matches the theme given for painting.
- 2) Effective use of graphic tools. Variety and need based selection of tools.
- 3) Richness of the colouring and composition. Finishing and total effect of the painting.
- 4) Painting skills like figure, rhythm, combination, balance, Naturally Perspective perfection.

II. Multimedia Presentation for students & teachers

- 1) Whether the student's work matches the theme given for presentation.
- 2) Design and total look of the slides. Selection of Lay outs, totality of language and its make up. Flow of Ideas and other communicative skills for the effectiveness of presentation.
- 3) Apt and fair usage of various software tools. Their relevance in the situation.
- 4) Fair usage of various effects, animations, links and other multimedia resources.

III. Web Page Designing

- 1) Whether the student's work matches the theme given for the web page. Language and style of presentation.
- 2) Proper and fair usage of variables, tags and other statements. Accuracy of syntax. Proper and readable presentation of the codes.
- 3) Fair and effective use of multimedia resources, links and other settings.
- 4) Design and total look of the web pages. Totality of implementation and its make up.
